(7) South 20 degrees 40 minutes 12 seconds East 121.30 feet to an oak tree: thence, (8) South 31 degrees 54 minutes 09 seconds West 269.40 feet to a red oak tree; thence, (9) South 02 degrees 15 minutes 12 seconds West 649.30 feet to a post and the aforementioned Bridgetown Road; thence, by and with the northerly side of said road the following three courses and distances: (10) South 81 degrees 17 minutes 03 seconds West 556.00 feet; thence, (11) by and with the arc of a curve, deflecting to the right, the chord of which bears North 86 degrees 59 minutes 53 seconds West 291,19 feet; thence, (12) North 79 degrees 94 minutes 20 seconds West 706.92 feet to the place of beginning, containing 40.345 acres of land, more or less. CONTAINING in all 104.1198 acres of land, more or less,

#### Parcel 2:

(C.C.L.R. 90/337), South 24 degrees 45 minutes 38 seconds West 955.22 feet to iron pipe "X" found (said pipe left remaining in place and now been inside of a large taller pipe set) (01/19/88); thence, (5) leaving the said Saulsbury Bros. lands to run and bind with the lands of Thomas R. Shipley (C.C.L.R. 232/110) South 26 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds East 121.50 feet to the beginning. CONTAINING in all 03.4688 acres of land, more or less.
